

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:

## This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or

- Do not immerse in water or liquid.
- · Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts of the appliance and its accessories.
- If the charger supply cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not incinerate the appliance even if it is severely damaged. The batteries can explode in a fire.

- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the OFFposition before picking up or carrying the appliance. Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing appliance that have the switch on invites accidents.
- Do not use appliance that is damaged or modified. Damaged or modified batteries may exhibit unpredictable behavior resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury.






# **Assembly and Charging**




Important: Plug in the machine immediately upon receiving. For maximum run time (up to 30 minutes in Eco mode), charge for 4 hours before use.









2. Attach the hose. It will click into place.




3. Wrap hose around bottom of machine and place on hose clip.





4. With machine switched OFF, insert charger into port The charging port door slides out of the way when charger is inserted. Plug the charger into a wall outlet.



**5.** The battery status indicator lights will illuminate when charging.

## Filling the Formula Tank



This machine is compatible with BISSELL® formulas made for portable carpet cleaners. Always use genuine BISSELL formulas in your machine. Use of other cleaning formulas may harm the machine.



Pretreat spots and stains to improve carpet cleaning performance.



Keep plenty of BISSELL formulas on hand so you can clean whenever it fits vour schedule.



Add Boost carpet cleaning formula enhancers to any formula to increase its effectiveness.





1. Choose your formula.\* Scan the QR code with your smartphone camera or visit global.BISSELL.com for formulas.

2. Remove clean tank by gripping clean tank handle and lift up.

3. Unscrew cap.



4. Fill with warm (140°F/60°C MAX) water to fill line based on the size of your mess. Do not use boiling water. Do not heat water in microwave.

Small Area: 414mL Large Area: 828mL



5. Add formula to the corresponding fill line.

Small Area: 59mL Large Area: 118mL



6. Replace and tighten cap onto tank. Align tank with machine and press down until it clicks into place.



## **Using Your Machine**

### Before You Clean

- Ensure your machine is fully charged.
- Vacuum to remove loose dirt from areas to be cleaned.
- Spray any BISSELL stain pretreat formula on soiled areas and allow to sit for a few minutes.
- Tip: For upholstery, work in small sections until area is clean.

## Attaching and Using the Tools



- 1. Unwrap hose. Attach your desired tool to end of hose grip until it clicks.
- 2. Press power button ON.
- **3.** Select **cleaning mode**. See below for more information.



4. Point tool above stain and press and hold trigger to mist solution over affected area.



5. Release spray trigger and gently scrub stain using bristles



6. Apply firm downward pressure with tool and slowly pull it toward you to remove stain. Release trigger and make "dry passes" to remove any remaining moisture. Repeat as needed until no water can be seen in nozzle.

## Cleaning Modes



**Eco Mode ENERGY-EFFICIENT POWER** 

Ideal for cleaning upholstery, flight of stairs, and auto interiors. Run time up to 35 minutes.



**Turbo Mode** HIGHEST SUCTION POWER

Ideal for pet messes, spills, and tough stains. Run time up to 20 minutes.

# **Emptying the Dirty Water Tank**





**1.** Empty dirty water tank when it reaches the "MAX" line. Do not let the water level fill above the MAX line.

Note: The machine's pitch will change and suction will stop once the MAX fill line has been reached.



2. Remove dirty water tank by tilting outward and carry to a disposal area.



3. Pull up on the dirty tank lid to remove.



4. Pour out dirty water and rinse tank.



5. Reinstall the tank lid.




6. Reinstall tank at an angle until it clicks into place.

# **Cleaning and Storing Your Machine**










1. Power OFF. Remove and rinse the tools under clean. running water. Allow tools to drv.

2. Press the release lever on the hose to remove from machine.

Rinse hose with clean water. Lift end of hose and stretch out to ensure all water is removed. Let dry completely before reattaching. It will click into place.



**4.** Wrap hose for storage. Store indoors in a secure. dry location.

## Using the HydroRinse<sup>™</sup> Tool (select models)

Use to clean out your hose after each use.



1. Attach tool to end of hose grip until it clicks.



2. Hold the hose and tool in an upright position with the machine ON. Hold down the trigger for 30 seconds. Be sure to empty the dirty water tank after use (see page 6).

Note: Other maintenance or service not included in the manual should be performed by an authorized service representative.

**NOTICE:** To reduce the risk of a leaking condition, do not store where freezing may occur. Damage to internal components may result. Store machine in protected, dry area at room temperature (4°C - 40°C).

## **Limited Warranty**

This limited warranty is provided by BISSELL® International Trading Company B.V. ("BISSELL") and applies in Australia and New Zealand. It gives you specific rights. You will receive the warranty that is applicable to the country where your product was originally purchased, as shown on the original sales receipt. If you use the product outside of the country where it was purchased, your warranty may be void in BISSELL's sole discretion. It may be necessary to obtain some of your personal information, such as a mailing address, to fulfill the terms of this warranty. ### **Limited Two-Year Warranty**

For two years from the date of purchase by the original purchaser, subject to the \*EXCEPTIONS AND EXCLUSIONS identified below, BISSELL will repair or replace (with new, refurbished, lightly used, or remanufactured components or products), at BISSELL's option, free of charge, any defective or malfunctioning part or product.

BISSELL recommends that the original packaging and original proof of purchase with the date of purchase and country where purchased be kept for the duration of the warranty period in case you want to redeem the warranty during the warranty period. Keeping the original packaging will assist with any necessary re-packaging and transportation but is not a condition of the warranty.

If your product is replaced by BISSELL under this warranty, then the new item will benefit from the remainder of the term of this warranty (calculated from the date of the original purchase). The period of this warranty shall not be extended whether or not your product is repaired or replaced.

#### \*Conditions of Warranty
